





NOTES:

- 1. Refer to SP.11 for Tree Protection Requirements.
- 2. Location of root barrier installation to be approved by ICC with classification of tree (ie. significant, highly significant) determined by ICC.
- 3. Length of root barrier to extend past the tree's drip line or to a length approved by ICC.
- 4. Root barrier installation to be in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.

- 5. Roots equal to or greater than 50mm that are cut and/damaged during works must be treated by an ICC approved Arborist. ICC to be contacted and tree root/s to be treated in a timely manner.
- 6. When working around trees, protection of the tree and its root system is paramount. Best practice standards and AS 4970-2009 (Protection of Trees on Development Sites) must be adhered to at all times.
- 7. All works around trees should adhere to any approved plans produced by a qualified professional.
